This is the Last Will and Testament of me James CRUST of Leake in the county of Lincoln, farmer. First I will and direct that all my just debts funeral expences and charges of proving this my Will, be fully paid and satisfied within a convenient time after my decease by my Executrix hereinafter named. Also I give and bequeath all and singular my personal estate and effects - whatsoever and wheresoever unto my wife Mary Ann CRUST to hold the same for her sole use and benifit for and during the term of her natural life or so long as she the said Mary Ann CRUST shall continue my widow And where as my son William and my daughters Hannah and Jane have already received from me in money and household effects to the value of twenty pounds each, I hereby will and direct that at my decease or at the decease or remarriage of my said wife Mary Ann CRUST (should she be the survivor) all my said personal estate and effects shall be sold to the best advantage and the proceeds divided amongst the rest of my children, Samuel, Robert, Susannah, Mary Ann, Sarah & Elizabeth in such manner that each of them my last named children shall receive the sum of twenty pounds lawful money unless they or any of them shall have received the like amount from me either in money or effects or in both during my life-time, And in case after such division my said estate and effects any surplus should remain then it is my will that the same be equally divided among my before named children. And I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my friend George BRACKENBURY of Leverton allotment in the East Fen farmer, trustee and guardian for my wife and such of my children before named as many at the time of my decease be under the age of twenty-one years and I likewise nominate and constitute and appoint my said wife Mary Ann CRUST executrix of this my will hereby revoking any former will or wills by me at any time heretofore made and declare this to be my last will and testament, In witness where I the said Testator have hereunto set my hand and seal this third day of April, One thousand, eight hundred and forty-six.
